

Department of Economics

The Department of Economics was established in 1977 and offers M.A. & M.Phil. programmes based on CBCS mode with intake of 70 and 15 (for 2015-16) respectively and Ph.D. programme as per the UGC Regulation 2009 with present maximum capacity of 24 enrollments. Admissions to these programmes are based on merit. There are three well qualified faculty members in the department who besides regular teaching undertake research and extension activities. Departmental research orientation and focus is primarily upon local and regional issues. Department is learner centric. It has a computer lab with 20 PCs and accesses to campus wide Wi-Fi facility. All class-rooms are LCD equipped and one with smart-board. Also, it has a Departmental Library with dedicated resources for Environmental Economics and texts of economics in vernacular language. The department has a small but dedicated base of alumni spread across the region. Department has adopted best practices which enhance 'skills for employment' among the students. Faculties are well-equipped with PC, Laptop and internet connectivity via optic-fiber network and air-conditioned chambers with all facilities for teaching, learning and research. Department strives to provide congenial atmosphere for bringing out best from students and teachers.
